

Inventory of the Estate Sale of Caroline Dozier

About 1949, Robert E. Lee Dozier, son of Caroline Foster Dozier, came to live with his neice, Annie Christopher Million. He brought with him his "papers" in shoe boxes. These "papers" were handed down to Evelyn Million Parks and then to me, Robert James Parks. Included was a poster advertising Caroline Dozier's estate sale on Dec. 27, 1916, and a small L&N Railroad account book with the following list of items, names and prices.

To connect these two items, I asked Ed Million, my grandfather, if he remembered the sale. He said he did. I asked if he bought anything. He couldn't remember, which was odd because the list said he bought an old mare for \$155, the most expensive property sold. Surely, he would remember that. So I asked him about the horse. He said, yes, he bought it – and sold it that same day for a \$5 profit. That's why he didn't remember the horse.

I have ordered this list alphabetically by the name of the buyer. The items were listed in Uncle Bob's list according to the item number. I have used his spellings (which varied). The sale was conducted at Caroline Dozier's home in Stringtown (about halfway between Million and Valley View on the Tates Creek Pike). She died about a year later in January, 1918.
